SUBJECT: Arc Fault Circuit Interruption Protection

As you know, the National Electrical Code (NEC) 1999 edition was adopted on January 1, 2000 in Miami-Dade County. The Building Code Compliance Office would like to bring to your attention a specific effective date included in NEC Section 210-12 of the adopted Code. The following is an excerpt of that section.

210-12. Arc-Fault Circuit-Interrupter Protection

- (a) **Definition**. An arc-fault circuit interrupter is a device intended to provide protection from the effects of arc faults by recognizing characteristics unique to arcing and by functioning to deenergize the circuit when an arc fault is detected.
- (b) **Dwelling Unit Bedrooms**. All branch circuits that supply 125-volt, single-phase, 15- and 20ampere receptacle outlets installed in dwelling unit bedrooms shall be protected by an arc-fault circuit interrupter(s). This requirement shall become effective January 1, 2002.

The manufactures are preparing for the implementation of this code section by developing a receptacle with integrated arc-fault circuit interrupter.
