

**RESOLUTION NO. CRA-02-2022**

RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE N.W. 7TH AVENUE CORRIDOR COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING THE AGENCY'S EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S DESIGNEE'S ACTION IN EXECUTING AMENDMENT NO. 8 TO THE CONTRACT WITH NEIGHBORS AND NEIGHBORS ASSOCIATION, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$80,000.00; AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OR THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S DESIGNEE TO EXERCISE ALL PROVISIONS CONTAINED THEREIN

**WHEREAS**, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE N.W. 7<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE CORRIDOR COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY**, that:

**Section 1.** The matter contained in the foregoing recital is incorporated in this Resolution by reference.

**Section 2.** This Board retroactively authorizes the Agency's Executive Director or Executive Director's designee action in executing Amendment No. 8 to the contract with Neighbors and Neighbors Association, Inc. (NANA) to extend the Agreement in an amount not to exceed \$80,000.00, in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by reference. This Board further authorizes the Executive Director or the Executive Director's designee to exercise all provisions contained therein.
