### IV. **SBD Section Reports**

- a. SBE Construction Business Outreach and Education (Lawanda Wright-Robinson)
- The report was presented by Carlos Ansuarez. i.
- The report collected data from December 1, 2022, to January 31, 2023. ii.
- Mr. Ansuarez advised staff there are no prompt payments issues. iii.
- Mr. Jeovanni asked if there were any firms that needed assistance with iv. bonding and loans. Mr. Ansuarez stated that a few firms inquired about loans, and the process of applying, however, they were not ready to apply.

## b. SBE - Construction Certification Report (Jeanise Cummings-Labossiere)

- i. The report was presented by Jeanise Cummings-Labossiere (SBD Section Chief).
- ii. The report collected data from December 1, 2022, to January 31, 2023.
- iii. Mr. Hamler questioned if the number of firms today compared to the number two years ago. Ms. Cummings-Labossiere stated that the numbers now are lower due to firms not submitting their recertification applications, or a possibility of a firm moving out of Miami Dade County.

- iii. Ms. Hamler asked what determines the measures. Ms. Johnson stated that the detailed breakdown is in the report. Ms. Johnson stated that if it is a single trade with no subcontracting options the project will have no local measures.

## d. SBE - Construction Utilization Report (Rossi Siewnarine)

- i. The report was presented by Patrick Hines (Special Projects Administrator)
- ii. The report collected data from December 1, 2022, to January 31, 2023.
- iii. There were no questions regarding this report.

## a. Miscellaneous Construction Contract MCC- 9-18 (MCM Corporation)

- i. The report was presented by Ginny Mirabel on behalf of MCM Corporation.
- ii. Ms. Mirabel stated that there hasn't been much movement since the last report, however the progress will change soon.
- iii. She mentioned that three (3) new jobs were added, which will change the numbers on the report drastically in a good way. Ms. Dorothy Brown-Alfaro stated that MCC-9 is supposed to have an update on the percentages according to the last meeting. Ms. Mirabel mentioned that Dorothy is correct however, no changes have been made since then.

## b. Project B- Jackson West Medical Center (W.G. Yates Construction)

i. Item deferred.

## c. Project E- Jackson South Medical Center (Turner Construction Company)

- i. The report was presented by Jordyn Hopkins on behalf of Turner Construction.
- ii. The contracted goal was 32.77% and their achieved goals was 30.71%.

iii. Ms. Hopkins advised that the goal will not be met, and they are working with Jackson to come up with a solution. Ms. Hamler inquired about not meeting the goal. Ms. Hopkins stated their were that happened along the way such as g contractors who pulled out of the project. She added that this is the result as to why the goal was not accomplished. Ms. Hopkins stated that they are working towards meeting their goal.

## D. Project F- Christine E. Lynn Rehabilitation Hospital (Turner Construction)

- The report was presented by Jordyn Hopkins on behalf of Turner Construction.
- ii. The contracted goal was 34.05% and their achieved goals was 42.3%.

## e. DTC Vertical Expansion (Turner Construction Company)

- i. The report was presented by Jordyn Hopkins on behalf of Turner Construction.
- ii. The contracted goal was 21.6% and their achieved goals was 19.99%.
- iii. Ms. Hopkins stated that they will meet their goal as there are a few payments remaining.

- ii. PCL Construction report was not added to the agenda packet due to time of submittal. Todd stated that the job is completed He added that the construction and goods & services SBE goal exceeded the expected goal.

ii. Mr. Armando Perez stated that the project is almost finished. They are on the 20<sup>th</sup> floor out of 25 floors. He added that the construction goal is 13.11% and their achieved goal is currently 15.95%.

- ii. Ms. Hamler asked what the percentage of completion is. Ms. Mathews stated that the project is 80% completed.

- ii. Mr. Wallace mentioned that they have exceeded all their goals in all three categories
- iii. Ms. Hamler asked what the company completion percentage is currently. Mr. Wallace mentioned that the company is halfway completed with the project.

### VI. New Business

### Discussion

- i. Director Gary T. Hartfield provided an update from the SBE Advisory Collective Board meetings. The Board created six topics to discuss and provide recommendations. 1. Prompt Payment 2. Local Headquartered Business 3. Set-Asides 4. Legacy Contacts 5. Implementation/Accountability 6. Change Orders.
- ii. Two of the six have been discussed in the meeting and the group will continue to meet until every topic has been addressed.
- iii. Mr. Dorothy Brown-Alfaro thanked staff for a job well done with the first Collective Board meetings. Ms. Brown-Alfaro mentioned that the meeting allows all three board members to collectively meet to discuss the common issues throughout the boards. Ms. Dorothy Brown-Alfaro stated that the meeting has been productive so far.
- iv. Mr. Hartfield stated that the goal of the Collective Board meeting is to discuss the all the topics and provide changes that will ultimately be heard by the mayor.
- v. Ms. Hamler asked if all county departments are using the County system informs. Mr. Hartfield stated that informs is used by everyone but Aviation, Water & Sewer, and PHCD.

- vi. Mr. Hartfield advised the board about Senate Bill 346 and House bill 383. He added that this bill will require SBD to place goals and measures on projects valued under three hundred and fifty thousand dollars. The bill will affect the construction industry as well as other SBD initiatives if passed. There are two more opportunities to amend the Bill before it reaches the State. He added that the County lobbyist as well as others are working hard to speak on behalf of their concerns.
- vii. Ms. Dorothy Brown-Alfaro mentioned her thoughts and concerns regarding the Senate bill 346 and House bill 383. She drove to Tallahassee and attended the meeting with the commissioners to express the Construction members thoughts and concerns as to why they disagrees with Senate Bill 346 and House bill 383.
- viii. Mr. Hartfield thanked Ms. Dorothy Brown-Alfaro passion and drive to help inform Staff and others on how to reach out to our commissioners in Tallahassee about our concerns. Ms. Brown-Alfaro, several business owners, and the Mayor went to Tallahassee and spoke to the commissioners passionately about what our different programs offer for Miami Dade County business owners.
