2022 TAX ROLL OPEN FOR COLLECTION

The 2022 Tax Roll of Miami-Dade County is now open for collection. Real Estate and Tangible Personal Property taxes as assessed from January 1 through December 31 become payable on November 1.

Early Payment Discounts:

4% if paid by November 30, 2022

3% if paid by December 31, 2022

2% if paid by January 31, 2023

1% if paid by February 28, 2023

Discounts are not available if payment is made in March

Property taxes become delinquent on April 1, 2023

Failure to pay property taxes will result in additional interest, fees, and penalties and could result in loss of property.

To view the amount due and/or make a payment log onto miamidade.county-taxes.com

When the discount period ends on a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday, payment must be made in person to the Miami-Dade County Tax Collector's Office by the next business day.

Payments can be made:

- Online by check or by credit card at miamidade.county-taxes.com
(Delinquent accounts that have a certificate issued or those in bankrupt status cannot be paid online)
- By mail – discounts on current taxes are determined by the postmark
