


## $\checkmark$ Relevant program information:

- On October 12, 2022, the County notified EPA and Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) of a Potential Force Majeure Delay for the CD Capital Improvement Projects (CIPs) in Construction due to the Tropical Storm Warnings issued for South Florida due to Hurricane Ian.
- On November 4, 2022, the County notified EPA and FDEP of a Force Majeure Delay impacting CD 3.3 Oxygenation Trains, and CD 3.4 Oxygen Production during the County's competitive procurement process. The two (2) responsive bidders elected to formally withdraw their bids during the final stages of contract negotiations.
- On November 22, 2022, the County notified EPA and FDEP that the electronic notification for Potential Force Majeure Notification reported on November 8, 2022 due to the Subtropical Storm Nicole had no
- impact on any of the Consent Decree projects in Construction. On December 7, 2022, the County notified EPA and FDEP of a request for Time Extension due to Force Majeure delays for CD 1.5 Effluent Pump Station at the SDWWTP.
- On December 28, 2022, the County notified EPA and FDEP of a Request for Time Extension and Project Status Update for CD 1.6 SDWWTP Gravity Sludge Thickening Facility, CD 1.8 SDWWTP Dewatering Facility, CD 2.12 CDWWTP Gravity Sludge Thickeners Plant 1, CD 2.13 CDWWTP Gravity Sludge Thickeners Plant 2, CD 2.16 CDWWTP Dewatering Facility and CD 2.18 CDWWTP Odor Control Systems. The CD Program continues to coordinate with EPA/FDEP keeping them appraised of construction
- progress and program efforts to mitigate delays or compliance risks.
